Welcome to the City of Crystal Lake. As a user of the City's sewer system, you are governed by the City of Crystal Lake Sewer Use Ordinance Number 7227, Section 1, Chapter 435. The ordinance sets forth terms and conditions a sewer user must meet in order to legally discharge into the City's system. Domestic users such as residential dwellings, condos, and apartment buildings are covered under the Ordinance, but do not require a specific discharge permit.

All non-domestic users must complete and return a general Wastewater Discharge Questionnaire (Form A) to the Wastewater Division of the Crystal Lake Public Works Department. Upon review of the questionnaire, the Pretreatment Coordinator in the Wastewater Division will determine if a Wastewater Discharge Permit is required. Non-domestic users consist of, but are not limited to, industries, commercial and food establishments, retail stores, food stores, offices buildings, gas stations, car washes, etc. Basically, any non-residential use is considered non-domestic sources due to the type of services they provide. Also incorporated into the Sewer Use Ordinance are provisions pertaining to the City of Crystal Lake's pretreatment requirements.

If you are in doubt whether you may require a Wastewater Discharge Permit, need to complete a Questionnaire or have any questions regarding the use of City sewers, please contact the Wastewater Division for assistance.
