**Temporary Liquor License Classifications**

**Class 16**

**Hours:**

Approved by Liquor Commissioner and City Council.

**Temporary Liquor License Fee:** \$20.00 (per 3 day period)

- **Temporary Liquor License issued to not-for-profit corporation.**
  - Retail sale of beer and wine for consumption upon the premises
  - The license shall be for a period not to exceed three (3) days.
  - Issued only for special events sponsored by the not-for-profit corporation requesting the license.

**Class 19**

**Hours:** Approved by Liquor Commissioner and City Council

**Temporary Liquor License Fee:** \$20.00 (per three day period)

- **Temporary Liquor License issued to not-for-profit corporation, including municipal corporations.**
- Retail sale of beer, wine and alcoholic liquor drinks for consumption upon the premises
- License for a period not to exceed three days and issued only for special events sponsored by the not-for-profit corporation requesting the license.

## **Class 20**

**Hours:** Approved by Liquor Commissioner and City Council.

**Temporary Liquor License Fee:** \$20.00 (per 3-day period)

- **Temporary Liquor License for a not-for-profit corporation or organization**
  - Retail sale of beer on the premises in packages only
  - No consumption on premises.
  - License period – 3 days
  - Issued only for special events sponsored by the not-for-profit corporation or organization requesting the license.

## **Class 30**

**Temporary Liquor License Fee:** \$100.00 (per 3-day period)

- **Temporary Liquor License for-profit retailers**
- 
- Approved by Liquor Commissioner and City Council.
- A Class 30 temporary liquor license shall authorize the retail sale of beer, wine and alcoholic liquor for consumption upon the premises and in the original package at an event for which a special event license has been issued by the City pursuant to Chapter 453 of the City Code. No sales pursuant to such license shall be made unless at the time of such sales, the license holder also holds a special use permit License for sales at such special event issued by the Illinois Liquor Control Commission.
- A Class 30 temporary liquor license may only be issued to a person or entity that concurrently holds a valid retail liquor license for on-premises sale and consumption of beer, wine and alcoholic liquor and/or sale of beer, wine and alcohol in the original package issued by the Local Liquor Control Commissioner as well as the Illinois Liquor Control Commission. The type of sales allowed by the temporary liquor license shall be limited to the same category of sales as identified in the applicant's retail liquor license.
- The license shall be for a period not to exceed three days and shall be issued only for special events which are licensed by the City pursuant to Chapter 453.
- Patrons of the premises where the beer, wine and alcoholic liquor drinks are to be sold are required to wear a non-transferrable, one use only, disposable wrist band or other means of identification identifying them as patrons of the area that is subject to the license
- Prior to the sale of alcohol pursuant to any liquor license issued by the Liquor Commissioner, the applicant must provide the City with a copy of the related liquor license issued by the Illinois Liquor Control Commission.
